Above the role of Watch Manager [Control], there is a role called Station Manager [Control] [2 posts], then Group Manager [one post], then Area Manager [one post], then Brigade Manager [one post], then Chief Executive [one post]. The names of the final two are already freely available to you on our website as they are part of the corporate management board. This element of your request is therefore refused under Section 21 of the Act – information reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means.
